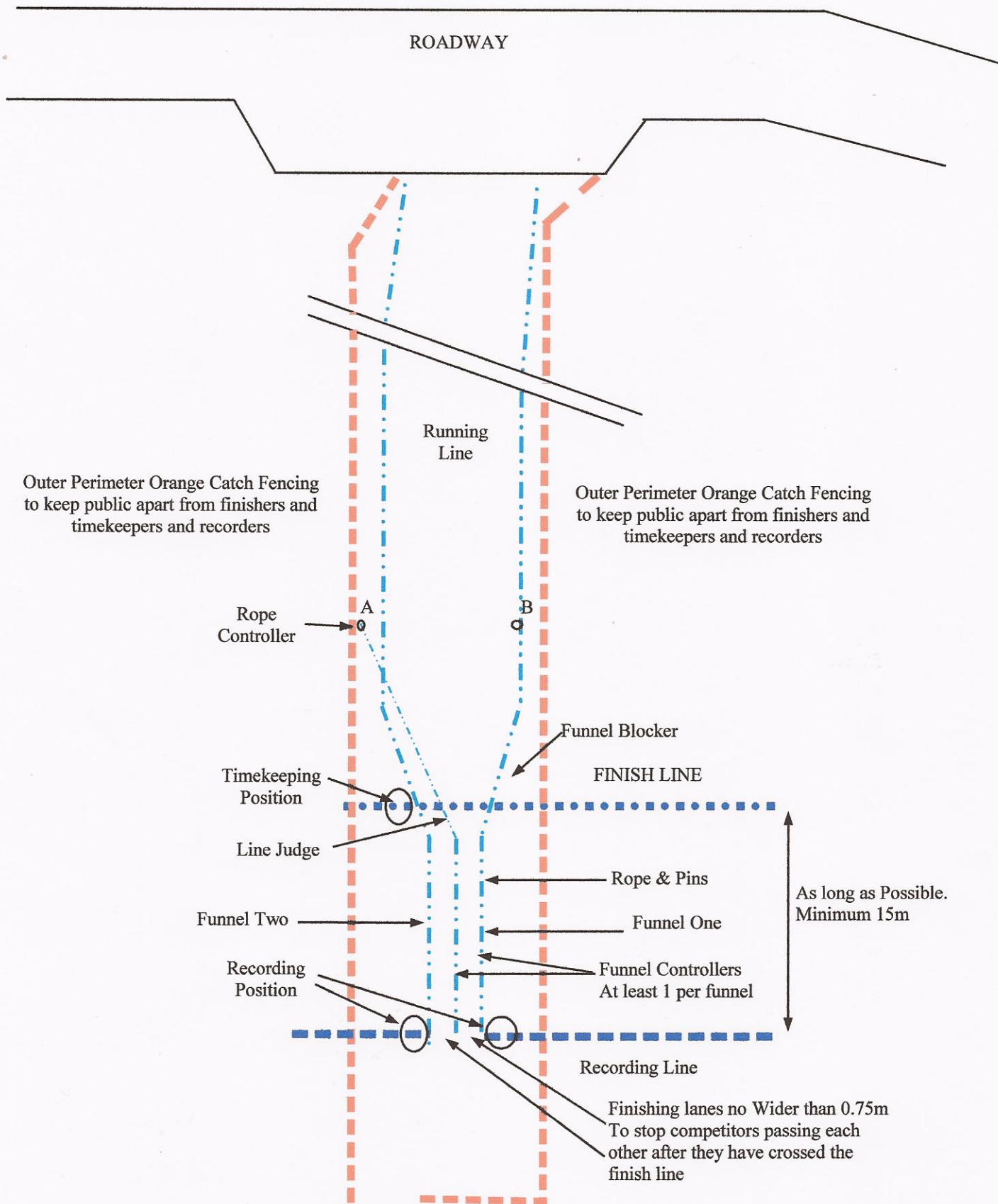


# EXAMPLE FINISH AREA

Start by sending the runners down funnel one, if for some reason the funnel becomes blocked (collapsed runner) or full (amount of runners finishing) then the rope controller closes funnel one by moving the rope from position A to position B. In an ideal world there would be enough recorders to cover both funnels. When funnel one is closed then a blocker needs to follow the last runner down the funnel, in case funnel has to reopen so the recorders know where the break is. This will allow the correct finishing order of ALL COMPETITORS
